

ORDINANCE NO. 12-24

CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ROXBURY, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE MAKING OF VARIOUS WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS, AND EQUIPMENT, IN, BY AND FOR THE WATER UTILITY OF THE TOWNSHIP, APPROPRIATING THEREFOR THE SUM OF \$260,000 FROM THE WATER UTILITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF THE TOWNSHIP

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Roxbury, in the County of Morris, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Township of Roxbury, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township") is hereby authorized to make various water system improvements, in, by and for the Water Utility of the Township, as follows:

- (a) Water System Improvements
Orben Booster Station Pump/Motor
Well No. 5 Improvements
Ford Road Booster Station Improvements

- b) Equipment Replacement
Water meters/equipment replacement
Hydrant and Appurtenance Replacements

Said improvements and acquisitions shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$260,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the improvements and acquisitions authorized and described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be raised from the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund of the Township. The sum of \$260,000 is hereby appropriated from the Water Utility Capital Improvement fund of the Township to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 3. Said improvements and acquisitions are lawful capital improvements of the Township having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said improvements and acquisitions shall be made as general improvements, no part of the cost of which shall be assessed against property specially benefited.


Section 4. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Township Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law.
