Motions/Discussion

THE COMMITTEES HEARD FROM William Talbot, who requested the issue be referred.

Mr. Talbot rents an Apt. 12 City. There is prohibition on smoking inside Building, But not on grounds. He has a young son living with him. Mr. Talbot contends other tenant smoke on grounds and the smoke comes in open windows and he is subjected to second-hand smoke.

THE COMMITTEE WAS SPLIT ON THE ONE HAND, this is a landlord/tenant issue. Some committee members wished to investigate the issue further, perhaps crafting a solution involving the ability for a tenant to break a lease if a smoking prohibition is not carried out by the landlord/tenant agreement.

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THE CHAIR SUGGESTED A TWO-PHASED APPROACH. THE CHAIR WILL REACH OUT TO LOCAL V. RENTAL PROP. OWNERS ASSOC. TO SEEK INPUT FROM THEIR ORGANIZATION.

SECOND, ALA. BLOOMER WILL CONSULT W/ CITY ATTY. TO SEE IF THERE IS A WAY FORWARDED VIA ORDINANCE, THAT WOULD BE IN SYNC W/ STATE STATUTE, AND ENFORCEABLE.
