6:45 PM BOARD OF TAX ABATEMENT,

Giancola, 103 Library Ave:

Board President Notte noted that Alderman DePoy, Chair of the abatement committee and Mr. Giancola have had a difficult time arranging a mutual time to meet. President Notte asked for a postponement of the hearing and to reschedule for June 1, 2015 at 6:45 PM. The request was so moved and seconded (Larson, Davis). **Motion passed.**

Whitney, 10 Chaplin Ave:

Alderman Davis read her report from May 4th. The report detailed the Whitney's struggle since 2013 when a banned pesticide was used in their home. The home is no longer inhabitable and will be torn down. The Whitney's have not lived in the home since it was sprayed and the water and electricity have been turned off. Based on calculations provided, the committee found that the abatement request was warranted and sought to abate in the amount of \$3,897.37. Alderman Davis so moved the committee's recommendation, it was seconded by Alderman Larson. **Motion passed.**

At 6:51 PM a motion was made and seconded (Larson, Davis) to adjourn. **Motion passed.**
