

BOARD OF FINANCE MONDAY, APRIL 23, 2012

Present: Mayor Louras, President Allaire, Assistant Treasurer Manning, Purchasing Agent Magro, Evan Pilachowski, and City Clerk Heck.

The Mayor called the meeting to order at 3:04 pm.

BID OPENINGS:

Bituminous Concrete Pavement:

President Allaire opened 4 bids. A motion was made and seconded (Louras, Allaire) to refer the bids to the DPW Commissioner. **Motion passed.**

Pavement Pickup at Plant:

President Allaire opened bids from Wilks Paving & Pike Paving. A motion was made and seconded (Louras, Allaire) to refer the bids to the DPW Commissioner. **Motion passed.**

Ballistic Vest:

President Allaire opened two bids one from Parro's and one from Rosen Uniforms. A motion was made and seconded (Louras, Allaire) to refer the bids to Captain Tucker. **Motion passed.**

Sweeper Attachment:

Two bids were received and opened, L W Greenwood and Sons and John Stokowski and Son. A motion was made and seconded (Louras, Allaire) to refer to the DPW Commissioner. **Motion passed.**

Sale of Hardwood from the Reservoir 15 Cord:

President Allaire opened 5 bids from various bidders, prices varied from \$452 to \$1112. After all bids were opened a recommendation from Scott Taggart to award the winning high bid of \$1,112 to Gagnon Lumber was made and seconded (Louras, Allaire). **Motion passed.**

BID AWARDS:

Captain Tucker recommended awarding the Ballistic Vest to low bidder Rosen Uniforms of Albany NY. A motion was made and seconded (Louras, Allaire) to award the bid for ballistic police vest to Rosen's Uniforms of Albany NY, at \$509.50 each with the total not to exceed \$5,095.00. **Motion passed.**

Mayor Louras briefly stepped out to take a phone call.

DPW Commissioner Pilachowski recommended awarding the bid of Pavement Pickup at Plant to Wilks Paving. A motion was made and seconded (Allaire, Manning) to award low bidder Wilks Paving (3/8 per ton @ \$69.50 & 1/2 per ton @ \$67.00). **Motion passed.**

At 3:20 PM a motion was made and seconded (Allaire, Louras) to adjourn. **Motion passed.**
