

A local law establishing income levels for real property tax exemptions for low income disabled citizens.
Be it enacted by the <u>Town</u> <u>Board</u> of the Town (Name of Legislative Body)
of <u>Sand Lake</u> as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE AND INTENT

This local law shall be known as "A Local Law Establishing Income Levels for Real Property Tax Exemptions for Low Income Disabled Citizens." The purpose of this local law is to recognize and update the real property tax exemptions for disabled citizens authorized under New York Real Property Tax Law and contained in the Town Code of the Town of Sand Lake.

SECTION 2. AUTHORIZATION

This local law is enacted pursuant to the requirements set forth in the New York State Real Property Tax Law §459-c to establish income levels for real property tax exemptions for disabled citizens.

SECTION 3. ENACTMENT

The Town of Sand Lake hereby adopts the following sliding scale schedule relative to the income levels and the percentage of assessed valuation exempt from taxation:

The Persons With Disabilities Exemption offered by the Town of Sand Lake pursuant to Real Property Tax Law §459-c, is hereby amended to provide exemptions as set forth in the following schedule:

Annual Income Exemption

50%

\$40,000.00 or less

Eligibility shall be determined in accordance with New York Real Property Tax Law §459-c.

SECTION 4. <u>REPEALER</u>

Any prior local law currently in existence that is inconsistent with the terms of this local law is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State.
