# ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW 1, 2023 – AMENDMENT OF LOCAL LAW #5 OF 2011-AMENDING THE DISABILITY TAX EXEMPTION

# Offered by Councilmember Michael McLoughlin Seconded by Councilmember Maxine Lautenberg

At the regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Saratoga, County of Saratoga, State of New York, held on February 13, 2023, the following resolution was made as indicated above,

WHEREAS, the Town Board has recognized the need to increase the Disability Tax Exemption due to inflation; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Saratoga has held a public hearing and received input from the townspeople; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED**, by the Town Board of the Town of Saratoga to adopt Local Law 1 of 2023, amending **Local Law #5 of 2011 increasing the Disability Tax Exemption**. (Local Law #1 of 2023 is attached.)

Subject to all of the conditions, definitions and requirements set forth in Section 459-C of the Real Property Tax Law, real property owned by one or more persons with disabilities, or real property owned by a husband and wife, or both, or by siblings, at least one of whom has a disability, and whose income is limited by reason of such disability, shall be exempt from taxation to the extent set forth in the schedule below:

#### Section 1 - Exemption granted and schedule of income eligibility

Section 375-6 of the Town Code of the Town of Saratoga is amended to read as follows:

Subject to all of the conditions, definitions and requirements set forth in Section 459-C of the Real Property Tax Law, real property owned by one or more persons with disabilities, or real property owned by a husband and wife, or both, or by siblings, at least one of whom has a disability, and whose income is limited by reason of such disability, shall be exempt from taxation to the extent set forth in the schedule below:

The income schedule set forth above shall be that for the latest preceding income tax year prior to the date of application. Where title is vested in either the husband or wife, or one sibling, their combined income may not exceed such sum.
