AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY REPEALING SECTION 340.120 B. 1. F., B. 2., and B. 4. OF THE SALISBURY, MISSOURI CITY CODE AND ADOPTING SECTION 340.120 B. 1. F., B. 2., and B. 4. IN ITS PLACE; TIME WHEN ORDINANCE WILL TAKE EFFECT.

Whereas, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Salisbury, Missouri have resolved to amend the rules governing the operation of golf carts on public streets within the City of Salisbury;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Salisbury, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. Section 340.120 B. 1. F., B. 2., and B. 4 of the Salisbury City Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. Section 340.120 B. 1. F., B. 2., and B. 4 of the City Code of the City of Salisbury, Missouri, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby approved and adopted.

Section 340.120 Golf Cart Use.

B.

1. f. Golf carts shall be operated upon the public streets only between sunrise and sunset except that golf carts equipped with a single or dual sealed beam headlight system in operating condition and at least one (1) reflector in addition to at least one (1) working taillight may be operated after sunset and before sunrise.

2 Operator's Permit. Any person desiring to operate golf carts on permitted streets within the City shall first procure a City operator's permit. An operator's permit for golf carts must be applied for at the City Police Station by completing a form prepared by the City and submitting an application fee of \$5.00. Upon receipt of the application and payment of the one-time fee of five dollars (\$5.00), the Salisbury Police Department shall issue an operator's permit unless a similar permit has previously been revoked or suspended, in which case the applicant must first obtain an order from the Salisbury Municipal Division of the Circuit Court of Chariton County permitting such reapplication and the order shall set forth the special terms, if any, which may restrict the reissued operator's permit.

4. Operator's Permit May Be Revoked Or Suspended. The operator's permit issued pursuant to this Section may be revoked or suspended by the Salisbury Municipal Division of the Circuit Court of Chariton County in addition to other penalties for violation of any City ordinance or City Code Section regulating the use of golf carts on City streets.
