**AN ORDINANCE OF THE SACRAMENTO COUNTY CODE AMENDING
SECTION 4.54.430 RELATING TO VIOLATION; PENALTY**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Sacramento, State of California,
ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 4.54, Title 4, of the Sacramento County Code is amended
to read as follows:

4.54.430 Violation; Penalty.

- a. A violation of this chapter is unlawful, and is hereby declared a misdemeanor and a public nuisance.
- b. In addition to any other remedy allowed by law, any person who violates a provision of this chapter may be subject to criminal sanctions, civil actions, a nuisance enforcement action pursuant to Title 16, Chapter 16.18 of this code or as indicated in this section.
- c. Each dangerous firework possessed and each unauthorized use of safe and sane fireworks shall be treated as a separate and distinct violation of this chapter subject to an administrative penalty as follows:
 1. \$1,000 for each dangerous firework or unauthorized use;
 2. \$2,500 for each dangerous firework or unauthorized use for subsequent violations within one year of the first violation(s);
 3. \$5,000 for each dangerous firework or unauthorized use for additional violations within one year of the first violation(s); and
 4. \$10,000 for each dangerous firework or unauthorized use which occurs within the American River Parkway, any park, and/or on school properties.
- d. Notice and Service. The citation, and any amended or supplemental citation, shall provide all the relevant information as required in Chapter 16.18, Section 16.18.206 A. 1., and be served by personal delivery or certified mail, postage prepaid and return receipt requested. Citations delivered by mail shall be addressed to the owner at the address shown on the last equalized assessment roll, or to the person in violation of this Chapter, or any other address ascertained to be more accurate.
- e. In the event of any conflict between the penalties set forth in this chapter and any penalties set forth in State law, the maximum penalties allowable under State law shall govern.

SECTION 2. This ordinance was introduced and the title thereof read at the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors on March 24, 2026, and on April 7, 2026, further reading was waived by the unanimous vote of the Supervisors present.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force on and after thirty (30) days from the date of its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days from the date of its passage it shall be published once with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the same, said publication to be made in a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Sacramento.

On a motion by Supervisor Desmond, seconded by Supervisor Kennedy, the foregoing ordinance was passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sacramento, State of California, this 7th day of April 2026, by the following vote:

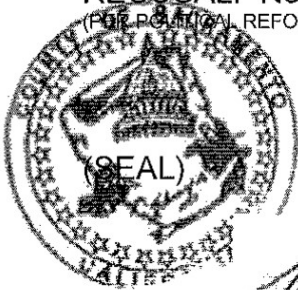
