TOWNSHIP OF SCOTCH PLAINS ORDINANCE NO. 2023-14

Ordinance Supplementing and Amending the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Scotch Plains, Chapter 7, Entitled Traffic, Section 7-6.2 "Stop Intersections" and Chapter 7A "Traffic Schedules" SCHEDULE VIII (Highlander Drive & Heather Lane).

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and the Township Council of the Township of Scotch Plains, County of Union, State of New Jersey that Chapter VII entitled "Traffic" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Scotch Plains is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION I. Schedule VIII entitled, "Stop Intersections" of Chapter 7A entitled, "Traffic Schedules" is hereby supplemented and amended by designating the following streets as Stop Intersections in the Township's alphabetical list of streets:

SCHEDULE VIII STOP INTERSECTIONS

In accordance with the provisions of Subsection 7-6.2, the following intersections are hereby designated as STOP intersections.

• Highlander Drive and Heather Lane

A STOP sign shall be installed on Highlander Drive at the southwest corner of the intersection

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY AND REPEALER.

If any provision or portion of a provision of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional, preempted by Federal or State law, or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of the ordinance shall not be invalidated. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent with any provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed as to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect twenty days following adoption and publication in accordance with the laws of the State.
