ORDINANCE NO. 2023-21

Ordinance Supplementing and Amending the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Scotch Plains, Chapter 7-3.4 Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours On Certain Streets and Chapter 7A, Entitled Traffic Schedules- § Chapter 7A-2 Schedule II –Parking Prohibited Certain Hours.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and the Township Council of the Township of Scotch Plains, County of Union, State of New Jersey that Chapter 7A entitled “Traffic Schedules” of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Scotch Plains is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1. 7A-2 SCHEDULE II entitled, “Parking Prohibited Certain Hours” of Chapter 7A entitled, “Traffic Schedules” is hereby supplemented and amended to include the following:

§ 7A-2 SCHEDULE II: PROHIBITED PARKING PROHIBITED CERTAIN HOURS

In accordance with the provisions of Subsection 7-3.4, no person shall park a vehicle between the hours specified, upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets.

Table with 4 columns: Street, Sides, Hours, Location. Row 1: Ascot Road, Both, 7:00 am – 9:00 am; 2:00 pm – 4:00 pm School Days Only, Entire Length, Between Edgewood Terrace and Morse Avenue.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY AND REPEALER.

If any provision or portion of a provision of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional, preempted by Federal or State law, or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of the ordinance shall not be invalidated. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent with any provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed as to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect twenty days following adoption and publication in accordance with the laws of the State.
