## An Ordinance to Amend Section 248-101-c of the Code of the City of Schenectady

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the City of Schenectady, in regular meeting convened, Chapter 248 shall be amended to include the italicized language and delete any struck language, as follows:

## **ARTICLE X Off-Road Vehicles**

[Added 7-28-1986 by Ord. No. 86-50; amended 5-24-2021 by Ord. No. 2021-09]

## § 248-101-c. Redeeming of off-road vehicles.

The owner of such off-road vehicle or his agent may, within 60 days from the date of impounding, redeem the off-road vehicle by paying to the City of Schenectady the sum of a \$70 towing and hauling fee and daily storage charges of \$20 per day for each day impounded, both of which to be set by resolution of the City Council. Upon redemption, such owner or agent shall also sign a written receipt for such off-road vehicle. Said sums shall be in addition to any bond required for the violation for which the off-road vehicle was towed, in addition to any redemption fee established in this Code, and in addition to any outstanding fines.
