ORDINANCE NO. 2024-04

Councilmember Mr. Williams

offered the following:

An Ordinance to amend Section 93-6 of the Code of Ordinances entitled “Civilian Police Review Board” to modify the manner of appointing vacancies to the Civilian Police Review Board.

The Council of the City of Schenectady in regular meeting convened, ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 93-6 shall hereinafter read as follows:

Section 93-6. Term limits, holdovers and vacancy.

- A. In accordance with the provisions of the New York State Public Officers Law, any member whose term has expired shall hold over until his or her replacement shall be named; any replacement shall hold office for the balance of the term. Any vacancy in office shall be filled by Mayoral appointment, with Council confirmation, of a successor for the balance of the term. The Board shall notify any nominating organization at least [60] 30 days prior to the expiring term of a person nominated by that organization. The Mayor shall make every effort to make such replacement appointment from said nomination or nominations within said [sixty-day] thirty day period. If a nominating organization fails to provide the Mayor with a recommendation for appointment within thirty days of the vacancy, the Mayor may appoint a member of the general public, representing no particular group or organization to fill the vacant term. Said vacancy appointment is subject to confirmation by the City Council.
- B. A member may be appointed to two consecutive terms. Upon the successful completion of two consecutive terms, the member may not be reappointed to membership on the Board for at least one year from the end of the last term in office.
