ORDINANCE NO. 2024-09

Councilmember Ms. Patrick

offered the following:

An Ordinance Extending the Temporary Moratorium on the Submission and Processing of Building Permits, Certificates of Occupancy, Certificates of Use and Land Use Approvals for Smoke Shops, Vape Shops, Hookah Lounges and Vape Consumption Businesses as the City Council Considers Changes to the Schenectady City Code Chapter 264.

Section 1. The Schenectady City Council is seeking to add Section 264-113 in the Schenectady City Code to regulate the location of smoke shops, vape shops, hookah lounges and vape consumption businesses.

Section 2. The Schenectady City Council approved a temporary moratorium on such businesses on March 11, 2024, and the temporary moratorium expires on June 10, 2024, and the Schenectady City Council now wishes to extend the temporary moratorium for a period of three months ending on September 10, 2024, or such time before upon the final passage and approval of Schenectady City Code Zoning Chapter Amendments creating Section 264-113.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
