RESOLUTION NO. 64

2024

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND OTHER APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH D&M CONSTRUCTION UNLIMITED INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES OF THE WESTON FIELD POOL.

WHEREAS, an Invitation to Bid was advertised for the construction of the Weston Field Pool and three (3) conforming proposals were submitted for review; and

WHEREAS, after review of the proposals submitted, it was determined that it would be in the best interest of the City to award the Contract substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A" to D&M Construction Unlimited Inc. for the reasons provided in the letter attached hereto from Eileen Cipriani, Business Administrator.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCRANTON that the Mayor and other appropriate City Officials are authorized to execute and enter into a Contract, substantially in the form attached hereto marked as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference thereto, with D&M Construction Unlimited Inc. to provide construction services of the Weston Field Pool.

SECTION 1. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause provision or portion of this Resolution so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The City reserves the right to amend this Resolution or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Resolution and the effective administration thereof.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is enacted by the Council of the City of Scranton under the authority of the Act of Legislature, April 13, 1972, Act No. 62, known as the "Home Rule Charter and Optional Plans Law", and any other applicable law arising under the laws of the State of Pennsylvania.
