AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND OTHER APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AND ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITH ENVIRONMENTAL SYSTEMS RESEARCH INSTITUTE, INC. ("ESRI") TO PROVIDE THE CITY WITH THE ArcGIS PLATFORMS, PREMIUM FEATURES, AND SUPPORT SERVICES AND TRAINING.

WHEREAS, Geographic Information Systems ("GIS") can provide municipalities with mapping and identification of city infrastructure, vital for maintenance of City assets, project management, liability exposure, and public safety; and

WHEREAS, Esri has been awarded a State Master's Contract (No. 4400022588) through the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to provide ArcGIS platform services and the City wishes to retain Esri for such services as outlined in the Small Enterprise Agreement — County and Municipal Government marked as Exhibit "A" and attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, in addition to said services, the City would benefit from access to certain premium license features outlined in the Quotation for Services marked as Exhibit "B" and attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the City would further benefit from support and training services to maximize the benefits of the ArcGIS system through Esri's Advantage Program, outlined in the Proposal for the Advantage Program marked as Exhibit "C" and attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCRANTON that the Mayor and other appropriate City Officials are authorized to execute and enter into the Contract and any related documents, substantially in the form attached hereto marked as Exhibits "A", "B", and "C" and incorporated herein by reference thereto, with Bsri to provide the ArcGIS platform, premium features, support, and training.

SECTION 1. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause provision or portion of this Resolution so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The City reserves the right to amend this Resolution or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Resolution and the effective administration thereof.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval.



SECTION 3. This Resolution is enacted by the Council of the City of Scranton under the authority of the Act of Legislature, April 13, 1972, Act No. 62, known as the "Home Rule Charter and Optional Plans Law", and any other applicable law arising under the laws of the State of Pennsylvania.
