RE-APPOINTMENT OF JAMES McDERMOTT, SCRANTON, PENNSYLVANIA, 18509 AS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS FOR THE CITY OF SCRANTON. MR. McDERMOTT'S TERM WILL COMMENCE JULY 1, 2024 AND EXPIRE ON JULY 1, 2029.

WHEREAS, James McDermott served as a member of the City of Scranton Board of Zoning Appeals appointed by Resolution No. 194, 2021; and

WHEREAS, James McDermott's expired term would create a vacancy on the Board of Zoning Appeals; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Scranton desires to re-appoint James McDermott, who is currently serving on the Board as a member of the Board of Zoning Appeals for the City of Scranton to a new five (5) year term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY SCRANTON CITY COUNCIL THAT James McDermott, Scranton, Pennsylvania, 18509 is hereby re-appointed as a member to the City of Scranton's Zoning Board of Appeals with said term to commence July 1, 2024 and expire on July 1, 2029.

SECTION 1. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The City reserves the right to amend this Resolution or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Resolution and the effective administration thereof.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval.


