AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 91 OF 2024 "AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FUNDS (SLIFRF) TO PERFORM STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS AT VARIOUS AREAS OF INTEREST WITHIN THE CITY OF SCRANTON", TO AMEND FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (Pub. L. No. 117-2) ("ARPA") is a \$1.9 trillion economic stimulus bill, passed by the 117th United States Congress and signed into law by President Joe Biden on March 11, 2021, that established the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund and the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, which together make up the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds ("SLFRF") program to speed up the United States' recovery from the economic and health effects of the COVID-19 pandemic and the ongoing recession; and

WHEREAS, on or about May 11, 2022, File of the Council 69, 2022 entitled "Authorizing The Mayor And Other Appropriate Officials Of The City Of Scranton To Take All: Necessary Actions To Implement The American Rescue Plan Act (Arpa) Grant Funds In The Amount Of Sixty-Eight Million, Seven Hundred And Forty-Six Thousand And Fifty Dollars 4 (\$68,746,050.00)" was signed into law; and

WHEREAS, as a recipient of an SLFRF award, the City of Scranton may use SLFRF funds to cover eligible costs incurred during the period that begins on March 3, 2021, and ends on December 31, 2024, as long as the award funds for the obligations incurred by December 31, 2024, are expended by December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, as the ARPA obligation deadline is steadfastly approaching, the City Administration has executed an Interagency Agreement ("IAA")/Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") to obligate funds for Stormwater Improvements, authorized by Resolution No. 91 of 2024; and

WHEREAS, since the adoption of Resolution No. 91 of 2024, the City had retained a deficit in available funding contemplated in the IAA/MOU and wishes to increase funds available for other unspent funds for the health, welfare, and safety of our residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCRANTON that the Mayor and other appropriate City Officials are authorized to execute and enter into the Amendment to the Interagency Agreement/Memorandum of Understanding,

substantially in the form attached hereto marked as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference thereto, so that the City of Scranton may so obligate State And Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) by and through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to perform stormwater improvements at various areas of interest within the City Of Scranton.

SECTION 1. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause provision or portion of this Resolution so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The City reserves the right to amend this Resolution or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Resolution and the effective administration thereof.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is enacted by the Council of the City of Scranton under the authority of the Act of Legislature, April 13, 1972, Act No. 62, known as the "Home Rule Charter and Optional Plans Law", and any other applicable law arising under the laws of the State of Pennsylvania.
