RATIFYING AMENDMENTS TO RESOLUTION NUMBER 336 OF 2023, ENTITLED "AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND OTHER APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BORTON-LAWSON ENGINEERING, INC. TO PERFORM CITY OF SCRANTON'S REQUEST FOR MINOOKA AND WEST SCRANTON STORMWATER ENGINEERING SERVICES" TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL SERVICES AND VENDOR'S UPDATED FEE SCHEDULE.

WHEREAS, through Resolution 336 of 2023, City Council authorized the Mayor and other appropriate city officials to enter into a contract with Borton-Lawson Engineering Inc. for work that includes the study, design, permitting bidding and construction phase consultation for stormwater management and drainage improvements in West Scranton as shown on the West Scranton Target area map; and

WHEREAS, Section 6 of the original contract allows for additional work at the hourly rates provided; and

WHEREAS, since the passing of Resolution No. 336 of 2023, an amendment is required for additional services and vendor's updated fee schedule to the contract; and

WHEREAS, it is the best interests of the City of Scranton and its residents to authorize the City to contract with Borton Lawson Inc. by and through the proposed amendments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution 336 of 2023 is hereby ratified to reflect the amendment that authorize the Mayor and other appropriate city officials to enter into an amended contract with Borton-Lawson Engineering Inc. reflecting additional services and updated fee schedule attached as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 1. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The City reserves the right to amend this Resolution or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interests of the promotion of the purposes and Intent of this Resolution and the effective administration thereof.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is enacted by the Council of the City of Scranton under the authority of the Act of Legislature, April 13, 1972, Act No. 62, known as the "Home Rule Charter and Optional Plans Law", and any other applicable Law arising under the laws of the State of Pennsylvania.
