CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEASIDE PARK COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$101,000.00 FOR MOBIMATS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF SEASIDE PARK, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$101,000 from the General Capital Improvement Fund, for the acquisition of capital equipment including but not limited to Mobimats with the acquisition of all materials and equipment for completion of all work necessary therefore or related thereto (collectively, the "Project").

Section 2. It is hereby determined and stated that the Project set forth in Section 1 is a general improvement and is not a current expense of the Borough.

Section 3. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provision of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith, and the resolution promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Direction of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Borough Clerk and available for inspection.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 5. The ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication as required by law.
