

ORDINANCE 2024-07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEASIDE PARK, COUNTY OF OCEAN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 225, ARTICLE I, SECTION 225-5, OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEASIDE PARK, ENTITLED "RECREATION ACTIVITY FEES"

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-1 et seq., the governing body of every municipality may make, amend, repeal and enforce such ordinances, regulations, rules and by-laws not contrary to the laws of this state or the United States, as it may deem necessary and proper for the good government, order and protections of persons and property, and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants, and as may be necessary to carry into effect the powers and duties conferred and imposed by law; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Seaside Park is a body politic and corporate in law pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:60-1 et seq.; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Seaside Park, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey:

SECTION I.

- A. The Borough Code of Seaside Park, Chapter 225 is hereby amended and supplemented under § 225-5, which is entitled "Recreation activity fees," so as to increase the minimum fee for farmers market, small space, from \$25 to \$30, and shall be read as follows:

- B. The Borough Code of Seaside Park, Chapter 225 is hereby amended and supplemented under § 225-5, which is entitled "Recreation activity fees," so as to clarify the Junior lifeguard summer program fees shall be per session, and shall be read as follows:

SECTION II.


All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies.

SECTION IV.


This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.
