

ORDINANCE NO. 861

AN ORDINANCE OF SELINGROVE BOROUGH, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 26-113, SCHEDULE A: WATER RATES AND CHARGES, OF CHAPTER 26, WATER, OF THE SELINGROVE BOROUGH CODE, THEREBY INCREASING SUCH RATES AND CHARGES, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The Council of the Borough of Selingsrove, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, duly enacts the following Ordinance.

Section One. Authority. The authority for the enact of this Ordinance is set forth in Sections 1201 and 1202 of the Pennsylvania Borough Code, as amended (53 Pa.C.S. § 46101 and 46102 as amended).

Section Two. Purpose. This Ordinance is being enacted to promote the general health, welfare, and safety of the community by amending water rates and charges to thereby increase the same for all customers of its public water systems for 2022 and all years thereafter.

Section Three. Amendment Of Section 26-113, Schedule A: Water Rates and Charges.

Section 26-113, Schedule A: Water Rates and Charges, of Chapter 26, Water, shall hence forth read:

The Borough does hereby fix and charge the water rates and charges set forth in the following Schedules of Water Rates and Charges, which water rates and charges shall become effective on, and shall apply to all water services provided after April 1, 2022, and shall be collected from the customers of the water system under operation by the Borough as lessee of the Selingsrove Municipal Authority.

A. Metered Water Rates

Quarterly Consumption	Charge per 1,000 Gallons
For first 3,000 gallons (minimum)	\$12.30
For all over 3,000 gallons	\$4.10

(1) Minimum Meter Charges. All metered customers shall be subject to, and shall pay, a quarterly minimum water charge based upon the size of the water meter on the line or main servicing the customer's real property as set forth as follows:

Meter Size (Inches)	Gallons Allowed	Minimum Quarterly Charge
5/8 to 3/4	3,000	\$12.30
1 to 1 1/4	21,000	\$86.10
1 1/2	50,000	\$205.00
2	87,000	\$356.70

6	757,000	\$3,103.70
8	1,250,000	\$5,125.00

(2) The customer shall pay on the basis of either the actual metered water consumption or the minimum meter charge set forth above, whichever results in the higher billing amount>

B. Flat Water Rates.

Swimming pools

When not billed through metered service,
not to exceed 23,000 gallons of water \$94.30

Any water in excess of 23,000 gallons
shall be billed at metered rates for all
water provided

The Water Rates and Charges set forth in this Schedule A shall henceforth be subject from time to time to change by a duly adopted resolution of the Borough Council of Selinsgrove Borough by way of a properly made, seconded, and carried motion of a majority of the councilpersons present at a duly advertised public or special meeting of said Council, which resolution shall be incorporated herein by this reference and shall have the same authority and effectiveness as if set forth herein at length.

The rest and remainder of Chapter 26, Water, of the Selinsgrove Borough Code are unchanged by this amendment and are hereby confirmed and ratified hereby.

Section Four. Repealer. Any and all Ordinance, or parts of any Ordinance, contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section Five. Severability. In the event a term, sentence, or provision of this Ordinance is deemed to be illegal or void then only such term, sentence or provision shall be stricken herefrom and the rest and remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section Six. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect on April 1, 2022.


Upon motion duly made at a public meeting, properly seconded, and carried, this Ordinance No. 861 is enacted this March 21, 2022.


