

ORDINANCE NO. 746

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 152 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF SELLERSVILLE, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA PROHIBITING THE USE OF BRAKE RETARDERS ON CERTAIN STREETS IN THE BOROUGH

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sellersville, Bucks County, that the Code of the Borough of Sellersville (the "Code") is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Amendment to Chapter 152, Article II of the Code

Article II (Traffic Regulations) of Chapter 152 of the Code is hereby amended by adding the following:

"Except in an emergency to protect the safety of people and property, it shall be unlawful for any person to use an engine brake retarder while operating a vehicle on the following streets:

Street	Between
Lawn Avenue	Farmers Lane and Maple Avenue
Maple Avenue	Farmers Lane and Lawn Avenue
North Main Street	Twelfth Street and Temple Avenue
Diamond Street	E. Park Avenue to Borough Line

SECTION 2. Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Severability

If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be separate, distinct and independent, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
