

ORDINANCE 2023-19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEASIDE HEIGHTS, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEASIDE HEIGHTS, SO AS TO AMEND CHAPTER 166, ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Seaside Heights, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Borough Code of the Borough of Seaside Heights is hereby amended and supplemented so as to amend Chapter 166 entitled "Police Department," so as to amend § 166-6 entitled "Employment of off-duty police officers" so as to add Subsection G. in its entirety so that it shall read as follows:

G. Off-duty police officers shall not be available under the provisions of this chapter for employment by or assignment to any establishment within the Borough that is licensed to serve alcoholic beverages, or any hotel or motel, or any other rental property.


SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
