AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE III DISTRICT REGULATIONS OF CHAPTER 165 OF THE CODE OF SHENANDOAH COUNTY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Shenandoah County, Virginia, that Chapter 165 of the Shenandoah County code, **"ZONING"**, is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 165-18. M-1 General Industrial.

F. Height regulations. Structures may be erected up to a height of 45 feet. Chimneys, flues, flagpoles, parapet walls, other accessory facilities not normally occupied by workmen, radio and television aerials, microwave towers and other public communications facilities are not governed by the height regulations set forth in this subsection, except that smokestacks, as defined in § 165-4, may only be allowed with the issuance of a special use permit. The building height may be increased through a special use permit, provided that required front, side and rear yards shall also be increased by one foot for each foot in height above 45 feet. A viewshed impact study may be required by the Zoning Administrator as part of a Special Use Permit request.
