ORDINANCE NO. 671-2026

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SINKING SPRING, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 196, SECTION 196-36.D, OF SINKING SPRING BOROUGH'S ZONING ORDINANCE

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sinking Spring, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ORDAINED AND ENACTED that Chapter 196, Section 36.D is hereby amended and restated as follows:

Section 196-36. Parking, Storage or Use of Major Recreational Equipment.

D. All major recreational equipment must be parked on a paved hard surface, either concrete or asphalt driveway or subject to Borough Zoning Officer review and approval, major recreational vehicles may be parked within the side or rear yard of a residential property provided that such major recreational equipment is parked on concrete blocks, placed under each wheel and any all other direct points of contact with the ground. Concrete blocks must be a minimum of 12 inches square and a minimum thickness of at least 4 inches. Proper lawn and landscaping maintenance shall be performed on all areas under and around the major recreational equipment.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective on the earliest date permitted by law.
