

LOCAL LAW NO. 12 OF 2024

A LOCAL LAW amending §312-72.1(H) and §312-72.2(A) of the Southampton Town Code to prohibit turns from Flying Point Road at its intersection with Diamon Court, Water Mill, between 6:00 a.m. - 10:30 a.m., from April 1<sup>st</sup> through September 30<sup>th</sup>.

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Southampton as follows:

SECTION 1. Legislative Intent.

To account for the increase in the volume of traffic over the last almost 10 years since this was initially adopted, this regulation is proposed to preclude vehicles from using Diamon Court and Mill Farm Lane, Water Mill to 'short cut' vehicles already in queue at the Stop sign located on Seven Ponds Road.

SECTION 2. Amendment.

Chapter 312-72.1(H) and §312-72.2(A) of the Southampton Town Code is hereby amended by deleting the stricken words and adding the underlined words as follows:

§312-72.1 Left turns prohibited.

No left turns shall be permitted in the following location:

- H. From Flying Point Road at its intersection with Diamon Court Monday through Friday, 6:00 a.m. - 10:30 a.m. between April 1st and September 30th, except for school busses.

§ 312-72.2 Right turns prohibited.

- A. At the intersection of Flying Point Road and Diamon Court, right turns from Flying Point shall be prohibited between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. from April 1 through September 30, except for school busses.

SECTION 3. Authority.

The Town Board is authorized to establish and promulgate rules and regulations regarding vehicles and traffic control pursuant to New York State Town Law §130 and New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law §1660.

SECTION 4. Severability.

If any section or subsection, paragraph, clause, phrase or provision of this law shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, any judgment made thereby shall not affect the validity of this law as a whole or any part thereof other than the part or provisions so adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law.
