Section 2. Payment of vacation time may be made on the scheduled pay period prior to the vacation provided written request is received two weeks in advance of pay period. The request shall be approved by the appropriate Department Head and Borough Administrator.

Section 4. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances, which are inconsistent herewith to the extent of the inconsistency, are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon due passage and final publication according to law.

*Any employee temporarily performing in an “Acting” capacity maybe be compensated at the discretion of the Governing Body in accordance with the salary range of the position that the employee is temporarily assuming.
