

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOMERDALE  
CONCERNING PARKING WITHIN THE BOROUGH**

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Somerdale, County of Camden, State of New Jersey that the Borough Code is amended to add the following:

**Sec. 247-20E**

No person shall park a motor vehicle in any parking lot open to the public between the hours of midnight and 6:00 am unless the business operation associated with the parking lot is open to the public or the parked vehicles belong to an employee working at the business operation associated with the parking lot.

**Sec. 247-28**

**A. Sleeping in Motor Vehicles Prohibited.**

No person shall at any time use any motor vehicle, located on any public or private highway, road or street, or any public parking lot or premises in the Borough for sleeping or living purposes.

**B. Undressing in Motor Vehicles Prohibited.**

No person shall at any time undress or change his or her clothes or don beach or wearing apparel in any vehicle, located on any public or private lot or premises, in the Borough.

**C. Undressing in Public**

No person shall at any time undress or change his or her clothes in the open on any public or private highway, road or street or on any public or private lot or parcel of ground in the Borough.
