**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE #1036
ENTITLED “TRAFFIC AND PARKING REGULATIONS FOR THE CITY OF SOUTH
AMBOY”, IN THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

BE, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that Ordinance No. 1036, entitled “Parking and Traffic Regulations for the City of South Amboy”, is hereby amended and supplemented, as follows:

Add the following:

SCHEDULE IV – TIME LIMIT PARKING.

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>TIMES</u>	<u>HOURS</u>	<u>LOCATION</u>
Washington Avenue 2 One hour parking Signs on the 500 Block	1 hour	8 A.M. to 6 P.M.	108 feet 9 inches from the curb line of Washington Ave/Walnut Street in front of 508 Washington Ave., and the second sign 54 Feet 2 inches from the curb line of Washington Ave/ Walnut Street

The invalidity of any section or provision of this Ordinance shall not invalidate any other section or provision thereof.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistency only.

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as provided by law.

This Ordinance is not subject to the approval by the Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles in the New Jersey Department of Transportation, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.

The City Engineer, under his seal as a professional engineer, shall certify to the Council that any designation or construction of signs or placement of markings has his approval. The City Engineer shall further certify to the Council that after his investigation of the circumstances, this Ordinance is in the interest of the safety and expedition of traffic on the public highways and

conforms to the current standards prescribed by the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways.

The City Clerk shall serve a certified copy of this Ordinance upon the South Amboy Chief of Police and the City Engineer.
