ORDINANCE #24-2019

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1036
ENTITLED "PARKING AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS"
FOR THE CITY OF SOUTH AMBOY, IN THE COUNTY
OF MIDDLESEX AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY.**

BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that Ordinance No. 1036, entitled "Parking and Traffic Regulations" is hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE V Handicapped Parking

Section 5-1 Special Parking for Handicapped
Section X Handicapped Parking

Add the Following:

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>LOCATION</u>
232 Henry Street	Beginning 430 feet from the curb line of Henry Street/South Broadway in front of Residence at 232 Henry St
231 David Street	Beginning 387 feet 2 inches from the curb line at George Street/South Broadway in front of the Residence at 231 David Street
233 North Feltus Street	Beginning 23 feet from the curb line on North Feltus Street/Fourth Street in front of the Residence at 233 North Feltus Street

Delete the Following:

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>LOCATION</u>
322 Henry Street	Beginning 302 feet West from the curb line at the intersection of Stevens Avenue and Henry Street and continuing 22 feet Easterly therefrom to the orange line marking the end of the parking spot.

The invalidity of any section or provision of this ordinance shall not invalidate any other section or provision thereof.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistency only.

This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as provided by law.

The Municipal Clerk shall serve a certified true copy of this Ordinance upon the South Amboy Police Department.

The foregoing ordinance having been introduced and passed on first reading by the Council of the City of South Amboy, in the County of Middlesex on Wednesday, October 16, 2019, will be considered for final passage and adoption at a public hearing held at a meeting beginning at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, November 25, 2019 at City Hall, 140 North Broadway, South Amboy, New Jersey when and where or at such time and place to which said meeting may be adjourned, all persons interested will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning said ordinance.
