LOCAL LAW NO.: 5 of 2026

LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF SOLVAY VILLAGE CODE BY
REPEALING SECTION 161-61.1 ENTITLED RESIDENTIAL FRONT YARD PARKING
AND CREATING A NEW SECTION 165-49 ENTITLED RESIDENTIAL FRONT YARD
PARKING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF SOLVAY AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Village of Solvay Village Code, being Local Law No.4 of 1991, as has previously been amended, is hereby further amended by repealing existing section 161-61.1 entitled “Residential Front Yard Parking” striking the existing section 160-61.1 entitled “Residential Front Yard Parking” and enacting a new section 165-49 entitled “Residential Front Yard Parking” to read as follows:

“§ 165-49 Residential Front Yard Parking

Parking within a front yard or front yard equivalent in a residential zone is prohibited other than in an established driveway.

165-49.1 Enforcement.

Enforcement of this section shall be undertaken by the Code Enforcement Office first by issuance of Notice of Violation and, if necessary, by prosecution through the Village Justice Court. Upon receipt of a notice of violation, the property owner shall be required to contact the Code Enforcement Office and schedule a reinspection to ensure compliance with §165-49. Failure on the part of the owner to schedule and be present for the reinspection shall constitute a continuing violation of this section 165-49 and shall subject the property owner to enforcement through prosecution in the Village Justice Court.

165-49.2 Penalties:

In addition to any other penalty set by the Court, a violation of this section shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$1000.00 per occurrence and may result in revocation of rental registry certificate where applicable. ”

Section 2: Local law No.: 4 of 1991, as amended, remains in full force and effect except as hereinabove amended.

Section 3: This local law shall take effect immediately upon posting and publication as required by law and filing with the Secretary of State
