

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH TOMS RIVER, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 16 OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT" AND SPECIFICALLY SECTION 16-1.2 ENTITLED "CONTAINERS; PICKUP SCHEDULE"

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of South Toms River, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey ("the Borough") that Chapter 16-1.2 of the Borough Code entitled "Containers; Pickup Schedule" is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows:

SECTION 1.

§ 16-1.2 Containers; Pickup Schedule.

- a. Unchanged.
- b. Unchanged.
- c. Unchanged.
- d. An automated refuse container can be obtained from the Department of Public Works. A second automated refuse container may be purchased at the rate of \$90 per container.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be part of the code of the Borough of South Toms River as though codified and fully set forth therein. The Borough Clerk shall have this ordinance codified and incorporated in the official copies of the Code. The Borough Clerk and the Borough Attorney are authorized and directed to change any Chapter, Article and/or Section number of the Code of the Borough of South Toms River in the event that the codification of this Ordinance reveals that there is a conflict between the numbers and the existing Code, and in order to avoid confusion and possible accidental repeals of existing provisions not intended to be repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of

this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance but shall be confined in its effect to the section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.


SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
