**ORDINANCE NO. 658**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STONYCREEK, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 498, AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE BURNING OF TRASH, RUBBISH, GARBAGE, REFUSE, DEBRIS, GRASS, WEEDS, BRUSH, TREES, LEAVES, OR ANY OTHER SUBSTANCE OR MATERIAL, EXCEPT IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES, REQUIRING THE OBTAINING OF A PERMIT PRIOR TO SUCH BURNING, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

SECTION 1. Section 6 of the Ordinance is hereby revised as follows:

"Fireplaces, bar-b-que pits, and charcoal burners are permitted if used for cooking, social or recreational purposes, not used to burn substances set forth in paragraph 1 hereof and not used to circumvent the intent and prohibition of this Ordinance."<sup>11</sup>

No permitted fire shall be kindled within 25 feet of a structure or flammable material. All open fires in the Township, whether permitted or exempt from permits, shall be constantly attended until the fire is extinguished.

The Township Fire Official is authorized to order the extinguishment of a fire by the person or persons attending the fire that creates or adds to a hazardous or objectionable situation.

SECTION 2. In all other respects, said Ordinance is ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
