ORDINANCE NO.: 2013-02

AN ORDINANCE OF SWATARA TOWNSHIP, LEBANON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO COMPLY WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF THE AUDITOR GENERAL'S REQUIREMENTS OF CURRECT PLAN DOCUMENTS NEEED TO BE FORMALIZED BY AN ORDINANCE.

SECTION 1: ESTABLISHMENT

This Ordinance establishes the adoption of the defined benefit pension plan for Swatara Township, Lebanon County, as previously set forth by Resolution No. 2007-06.

SECTION 2: ESTABLISHMENT

This Ordinance establishes a VOYA FINANCIAL as the plan's custodian of assets, through the 3rd party administration of the R.J. Hall Company, Inc., to provide this defined benefit retirement plan to the Township.

SECTION 3: SAVINGS PROVISIONS

In the event that any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of the Retirement Plan shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of the Non-Uniformed Retirement Plan. It being the intent of the Township that such remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its passage or adoption.
