

BOROUGH OF TAYLOR

ORDINANCE No. 4 of 2021

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FINANCIAL OFFICERS OF TAYLOR HOSE & ENGINE COMPANY, NO. 1 AND TAYLOR FIRE AND RESCUE TO REMIT INVOICES TO INSURANCE CARRIERS FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY THE TAYLOR HOSE & ENGINE COMPANY NO. 1 AND TAYLOR FIRE AND RESCUE RELATED SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Taylor, Mayor and Borough Council have determined that the Borough's two volunteer Fire Departments and related services must have the ability to render fees for services provided to help defray the costs associated with providing such services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF TAYLOR.

SECTION 1. That the Taylor Hose & Engine Company No. 1 and Taylor Fire and Rescue financial officers have the ability to obtain insurance information from the individuals, businesses, and institutions who receive services of the Taylor Hose & Engine Company No. 1 and Taylor Fire and Rescue, for the purpose of billing the same.

SECTION 2. Insurance information will be obtained by the Taylor Hose & Engine Company No. 1 and Taylor Fire and Rescue for the purpose of seeking reimbursement or billing for services related to, but not limited to Vehicle Accidents, Ambulance responses, Rescues, Structural Fires, Vehicle Fires, Chemical Spills.


SECTION 3. It is further provided that the above hose companies are hereby authorized to seek donation, contribution and/or reimbursement from the appropriate insurance companies, if applicable, for any costs relating to services rendered by the hose company. It is further provided that the hose company shall not bill the individuals directly for any services rendered nor premises service upon same.

SECTION 4. That provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any part of this ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the validity of the remaining provisions shall be unaffected thereby. It is the intent of the Borough Council of Taylor that this ordinance would have been adopted, had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid part not been included herein.

SECTION 5. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication according to law.
