

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOSITION OF A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT SALES TAX IN THE CITY OF TARKIO, MISSOURI.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Tarkio, Missouri (the "City") desires to impose a sales tax pursuant to Section 94.577 *et seq.* of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended, for the purpose of paying the costs of purchasing a new firetruck and future improvements to City buildings and equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, a majority of the votes cast by the qualified voters of the City voting thereon, has approved the imposition of said sales tax.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF TARKIO, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** There is hereby imposed a sales tax in the amount of one-half cent on all retail sales made in the City which are subject to taxation under the provisions of Sections 144.010 to 144.525, inclusive, of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended, for the purpose of purchasing a new firetruck and future improvements to City buildings and equipment

**Section 2.** The imposition of said sales tax shall become effective as provided by law upon approval thereof by a majority of the votes cast on the proposition by the qualified voters of the City voting thereon.

**Section 3.** The City Clerk shall forward to the Director of Revenue of the State of Missouri by United States certified or registered mail (1) a certified copy of this Ordinance, (2) a copy of the abstract of the votes cast on the proposition at said election and (3) a map clearly showing the boundaries of the City.

**Section 4.** If any clause, word, paragraph, section or other part or portion of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional for any reason, the Board of Aldermen hereby declares it would nevertheless have enacted the remaining portions thereof and such remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
