ORDINANCE NO. 02024-0516

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 295 OF THE VILLAGE CODE PERTAINING TO PUBLIC NUISANCES AND SEIZURE OF VEHICLES

WHEREAS, Chapter 295 of the Village Code sets forth the provisions regarding the seizure and impoundment of motor vehicles used the commission of certain offenses; and,

WHEREAS, the offenses for which a vehicle may be seized and impounded do not include certain theft offenses; and,

WHEREAS, all types of theft offenses may include the use of a vehicle; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 295 should be amended to include all types of theft offenses as those types of offenses for which a vehicle may be seized and impounded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Tilton, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 295-24(A)(29) of the Village Code shall be amended to read as follows:

(29) The driver or passenger of a motor vehicle commits any violation of Article VIII, pertaining to Theft, of the Village Code or similar violation of the Illinois Criminal Code.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: This amendatory Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form.
