

ORDINANCE NO. O2024-0516

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 295 OF THE VILLAGE CODE
PERTAINING TO PUBLIC NUISANCES AND SEIZURE OF VEHICLES**

WHEREAS, Chapter 295 of the Village Code sets forth the provisions regarding the seizure and impoundment of motor vehicles used the commission of certain offenses; and,

WHEREAS, the offenses for which a vehicle may be seized and impounded do not include certain theft offenses; and,

WHEREAS, all types of theft offenses may include the use of a vehicle; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 295 should be amended to include all types of theft offenses as those types of offenses for which a vehicle may be seized and impounded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Tilton, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 295-24(A)(29) of the Village Code shall be amended to read as follows:

(29) The driver or passenger of a motor vehicle commits any violation of Article VIII, pertaining to Theft, of the Village Code or similar violation of the Illinois Criminal Code.

SECTION 3: This amendatory Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form.
