ORDINANCE NO. 7-2024

AN ORDINANCE OF TRAFFORD BOROUGH, ALLEGHENY AND WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA VACATING AND REPEALING PART I, CHAPTER 46, ARTICLES I & II OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF TRAFFORD BOROUGH IN THEIR ENTIRETIES ADOPTING A NEW CHAPTER 46, ARTICLE I, CONFIRMING THE ABOLISHMENT OF COUNCIL AND MAYOR COMPENSATION.

WHEREAS, on October 3, 1989, the Trafford Borough Council enacted Chapter 46, Articles I & II which established compensation for Mayor and Council; and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council has since elected to forego any compensation for their service; and

WHEREAS, Trafford Borough Council desires to confirm Mayor and Council's election by repealing Chapter 46, including both Articles I and II, and enacting a new Chapter 46; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Trafford Borough Council, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION 1. REPEAL AND REENACTMENT OF PART I, CHAPTER 46 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF TRAFFORD BOROUGH

Part I, Chapter 46 of the Codified Ordinances of Trafford Borough entitled "Salaries and Compensation" including both Article I and II, is hereby repealed in its entirety and a new Part I, Chapter 46, is enacted to read as follows:

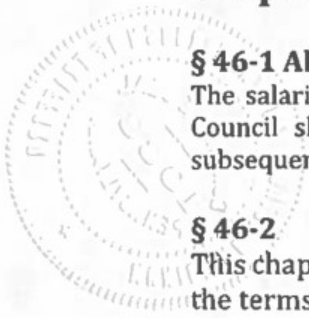
**Part I, Administrative Legislation
Chapter 46 Salaries and Compensation**

§ 46-1 Abolishment of Salary

The salaries of Mayor and Council are hereby confirmed to have been abolished and Mayor and Council shall be entitled to no monthly salary unless otherwise reinstated prospectively by subsequent Ordinance.

§ 46-2

This chapter hereby repeals any ordinance or part of an ordinance which is inconsistent with the terms herein to the extent of the inconsistency.



§ 46-3 Severability.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this chapter is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this chapter. Trafford Borough Council hereby declare that they would have passed this chapter, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional.

§ 46-4 When effective.

This chapter shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately from and after the date of its final passage and adoption.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED at a regular meeting of the Council of the Borough of Trafford, County of Allegheny and Westmoreland, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, a full quorum being present, the 31st day of December, 2024.




