ORDINANCE 2024.03.02

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPLIT SHIFTS FOR ELECTION WORKERS

WHERAS, Wis. Stats. §7.30(1) grants authority to the Town Board of the Town of Trenton, Washington County, Wisconsin, to establish split shifts for election workers; and

WHERAS, proper notice has been given for the consideration and adoption of this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, this ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of 2 sets of officials to work at different times on each election day as follows:

There shall be 2 shifts for election workers on all election days. The first shift shall commence at 6:30 a.m. and end at 1:30 p.m. The second shift shall commence at 1:30 p.m. and end with the completion of all required election-day duties that follow the closure of the polls.
