

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A TAX FOR GENERAL REVENUE DEDICATED FOR PUBLIC SAFETY (LAW ENFORCEMENT) PURPOSES ON ALL SELLERS FOR THE PRIVILEGE OF ENGAGING IN THE BUSINESS OF SELLING TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR RENDERING TAXABLE SERVICES AT RETAIL AT THE RATE OF ONE HALF OF ONE PERCENT ON THE RECEIPTS FROM THE SALE AT RETAIL OF ALL TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR TAXABLE SERVICES AT RETAIL WITHIN THE CITY OF TRUESDALE, IF SUCH PROPERTY AND SERVICES ARE SUBJECT TO TAXATION BY THE STATE OF MISSOURI UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 144.010 TO 144.527 RSMO, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY AND SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 94.500 TO 94.550 RSMO AND PROVIDING FOR SUBMISSION OF THIS ORDINANCE TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TRUESDALE FOR THEIR APPROVAL AT THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION CALLED AND TO BE HELD IN SAID CITY ON TUESDAY, APRIL 2, 2024.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Sections 94.500 to 94.550 RSMo, the cities of the state are empowered to impose by ordinance, for general purposes dedicated to public safety (law enforcement), a tax for general revenue, public safety (law enforcement) purposes on all sellers for the privilege of engaging in the business of selling tangible personal property or rendering taxable services at the rate of one-half of one percent, at seven-eighths of one percent, or at one percent on the receipts from the sale at retail of all tangible personal property or taxable services at retail within any city adopting such tax, if such property and services are subject to taxation by the State of Missouri under the provisions of Section 144.010 to 144.527 RSMo, and The City of Truesdale desires to avail itself of such authorization and within the terms thereof, and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 94.500 to 94.550 RSMo, no ordinance enacted pursuant to the authority granted by the provisions of said Sections shall be effective until it has been submitted to the qualified voters of the city and approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting thereon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF TRUESDALE.

Section 1. Imposition of city sales tax. Pursuant to the authority granted by and subject to the provisions of Sections 94.500 to 94.550 RSMo, a tax for general revenue, public safety (law enforcement) purposes hereby is imposed upon all sellers for the privilege of engaging in the business of selling tangible personal property or rendering taxable services at retail to the extent and in the manner provided in Section 144.010 to 144.527 RSMo and the rules and regulations of the Director of Revenue issued pursuant thereto. The rate of the tax shall be one half of one percent on the receipts from the sale at retail of all tangible personal property or taxable services at retail within The City Truesdale, Missouri, if such property and taxable services are subject to taxation by the State of Missouri under the provisions of Sections 144.010

to 144.527 RSMo The tax shall become effective as provided in subsection 2 of Section 32.087 RSMo and shall be collected pursuant to the provisions of Section 94.500 to 94.550 RSMo.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be submitted to the qualified voters of The City of Truesdale, Missouri, for their approval, as required by the provisions of Section 94.510 RSMo, at the General Municipal election hereby called and to be held in said city on Tuesday, the 2nd day of April, 2023. The ballot title will be:

Shall the City of Truesdale impose a general sales tax of one-half of one percent for public safety purposes, dedicated to the Truesdale Police Department?



If a majority of the qualified voters voting at said election shall vote in favor of the approval of this ordinance, then the same shall be binding and in full force and effect.


Section 3. Within ten (10) days after the approval of this ordinance by the qualified voters of The City of Truesdale, Missouri, the City Clerk shall forward to the Director of Revenue of the State of Missouri by United States registered mail or certified mail, a certified copy of this ordinance together with certifications of the election returns and accompanied by a map of the city clearly showing the boundaries thereof.
