

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TWIN OAKS MUNICIPAL CODE BY REPEALING SECTION 130.150, OPTING OUT OF THE SALES TAX HOLIDAY

**WHEREAS**, with the passage of Senate Bill 153, signed into law in 2021, local governments no longer have the option to exempt local sales taxes from the annual Back-to-School sale tax holiday occurring on the first weekend in August annually; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board now seeks to repeal Section 130.150 exempting the City's local sales taxes from the holiday.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF TWIN OAKS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** Section 130.150, entitled "Opt Out of State Imposed Sales Tax Holiday," is hereby repealed in its entirety and reserved for future use.

**Section 2:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
