AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL SECTIONS 500.030 TO 500.035 CONCERNING THE ADOPTION AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE ELECTRICAL CODE OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF UNION AND ENACT IN THEIR STEAD A REVISED ELECTRICAL CODE AND ESTABLISHING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF UNION, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Repeal

That Sections 500.030 to 500.035 concerning the adoption and administration of the National Electrical Code (2008 Edition) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Union are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Adoption

That the following sections are hereby enacted:

Section 500.030 Adoption of Electrical Code.

- A. A certain document, one (1) copy of which is on file in the office of the City Engineer of the City of Union, being marked and designated as the 2020 NFPA 70, National Electric Code (NEC), be it hereby adopted as the Electrical Code of the City of Union, Missouri, for the control of building and structures as herein provided; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Electrical Code are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this Section, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in Section 500.035 of this Chapter.
- B. Penalty. Any person violating any of the provisions of the Code adopted in this Section shall be deemed guilty of an ordinance violation and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in an amount not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or be imprisoned in the City or County Jail for a period of not exceeding ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment. Each day such violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such hereunder.

Section 500.035 Additions, Insertions, Deletions and Changes.

- A. The following Sections of the 2020 NFPA 70, National Electric Code (NEC) are hereby revised as follows:
 1. 210.11 Garage branch circuits
 - A. Add the following sentence: "Garage door opener receptacles located in the ceiling and dedicated appliance receptacles shall be a simplex."
 2. 210.12 Arc-Fault circuit-interrupter protection
 - A. Delete section.
 3. 210.52 (B)(1) Receptacle outlets served
 - A. Delete exception 2.
 - B. Add the following exception: "A receptacle for a built-in microwave or refrigeration appliance shall be supplied from an individual branch circuit rated 20 amperes."
 4. 210.52 (G)(3) Basements
 - A. Add the following sentence: "Sump pump receptacle shall be a simplex."
 5. 230.70 (A)(1) Readily accessible locations
 - A. Add the following sentence: "Maximum of five (5) feet from nearest point of entry."
 6. 334.15 (B) Protection from physical damage
 - A. Add the following sentence: "All cables and wires exiting at the panel box location

- shall be protected, and covered, by an approved finish.”
7. 406.4 (D)(4) Arc-fault circuit interrupter protection
 - A. Delete section.
 8. 406.9 (A) Damp locations
 - A. Delete the following statement: "(attachment plug cap not inserted and receptacle covers closed)."
 9. 406.9 (B)(1) Receptacles of 15 and 20 amperes in a wet location
 - A. Delete the following statement: "whether or not the attachment plug cap is inserted."
 10. 422.5 GFCI protection for personnel
 - A. Delete (6) Sump Pumps
 - B. Delete (7) Dishwashers

Section 3. Inconsistent Ordinances Repealed

That any ordinance or parts of ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Saving Clause

That no section, or portion of any section of this ordinance, if for any reason, is held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 5. Codifier to Number Sections

It is the intent of the Board of Alderman, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Union, Missouri and the sections of this ordinance shall be numbered by the codifier to accomplish such intent.

Section 6. Effective Date.

That this ordinance shall take full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the Board of Alderman and approval by the Mayor, the public interest so requiring.
