ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-15-74 (AVOIDABLE ALARM CHARGES) OF THE UTICA CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES

ORDAINED, that Section 2-15-74(a) of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) Each alarm user shall pay to the City a charge for each and every avoidable alarm to which the City responds, in each calendar year, as follow:

Table with 2 columns: Alarm type and Charge amount. Rows include: First two avoidable alarms each calendar year (No charge), Third Avoidable Alarm (\$75), Fourth Avoidable Alarm (\$100), Fifth and subsequent alarm (\$150).

FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
