## AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND REPLACING SECTION 135.390 GROUP MEDICAL INSURANCE

WHEREAS, Section 135.390 Group Medical Insurance currently provides that coverage for a new employee and his/her eligible dependents shall begin on the first day of the calendar month following the employee's successful completion of his/her ninety-day probation period; and

**WHEREAS**, City Administration has been advised that this section should be amended to be more clearly in compliance with the Affordable Care Act.

### THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALERMEN OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

### **I. SECTION REPEALED**

#### Section 135.390 Group Medical Insurance.

All full-time employees, and dependent family members at the employee's discretion, shall be provided group medical insurance, at a cost to be determined annually at the renewal date of the group policy. Coverage for a new employee and his/her eligible dependents shall begin on the first day of the calendar month following the employee's successful completion of his/her ninety-day probationary period.

## **II. SECTION REPLACED**

### Section 135.390Group Medical Insurance.

All full-time employees, and dependent family members at the employee's discretion, shall be provided group medical insurance, at a cost to be determined annually at the renewal date of the group policy. Coverage for a new employee and his/her eligible dependents shall begin on the first day of the calendar month following the employee's completion of sixty (60) days of employment.

## **III. ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT**

All ordinances in conflict herewith, or to the same effect hereof, are hereby ordered repealed.

## **IV. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval.
