**Resolved**, that the Village Board of Trustees amends Chapter 158, Vehicles & Traffic, of the Village Code, to add Stop Signs at Certain Intersections and establish a School Zone and School Speed Limit with Local Law #1-24:

**Add Chapter § 158 Article V Establishment of School Zone and School Speed Limit**

**§ 158-25. Establishment of School Zone and School Speed Limit**

**A. The following street in the Village of Victor is hereby designated a School Zone for purposes of safety and traffic enforcement:**
