ORDINANCE NO. 2024- 30

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2009-68, AS AMENDED, CHAPTER 660, SECTION 660-9.2 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF VINELAND ENTITLED TOBACCO AND VAPOR PRODUCTS.

WHEREAS, on October 27, 2009, City Council adopted Ordinance 2009-68, Chapter 660-9.2 of the Code of the City of Vineland entitled Tobacco and Vapor Products; Violations and Penalties; and

WHEREAS, Section 660-9.2C incorrectly identifies the license suspension penalty for violating the Municipal Code as impacting a retail food establishment licenses instead of a Retail Electronic Smoking Establishment license; and

WHEREAS, said Section 660-9.2C further sets forth the penalty for a third or subsequent offense where said identified penalty therein is for a first offense.

WHEREAS, City Council wishes to correct the errors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Vineland that Ordinance 2009-68, Chapter 660, Section 660-9.2 C be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

- C. The Health Officer may suspend the Retail Electronic Smoking Establishment license of any person convicted of a first violation of this article for a period of not more than three days pursuant to the authority of the Health Department to license and regulate Retail Electronic Smoking Establishments.

BE IT FURTHER ORDANED that the balance of Ordinance 2009-68, as amended not amended hereby shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that should any portion of this Ordinance be deemed unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the balance hereof not deemed unenforceable shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that should any Ordinance or portion thereof be inconsistent herewith, the same shall be deleted to the extent of such inconsistency.




