ORDINANCE NO. 20

TOWNSHIP OF WAYNE
COUNTY OF PASSAIC
STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT
CHAPTER 200 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC),
ARTICLE XI (SCHEDULES) OF THE CODE OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF WAYNE**

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-197(1)(h) provides, *inter alia*, that a municipality may pass, without the approval of the Commissioner of Transportation, and consistent with the current standards prescribed by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, ordinances regulating the entrances to and exits from parking yards and parking places which are open to the public or to which the public is invited, except that this shall not apply to entrances or exits to and from State highways; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.2 further provides that any municipality, which maintains a paid police force, may, by ordinance, resolution, or regulation, pursuant to R.S. 39:4-197 and with the consent of the governing body of the county, regulate traffic and parking along and upon any county road or part thereof, lying within its corporate limits, in the same manner and to the same extent that it is authorized by law to regulate the same upon municipal roads and streets; and

WHEREAS, for the health, safety and welfare of the general public operating motor vehicles on Wayne Township roads, it is necessary to amend Schedule XVII: Prohibited Turns at Intersections; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 200 (Vehicles and Traffic) Article XI (Schedules), Section 200-45 (Schedule XVII: Prohibited Turns at Intersections) of the Code needs to be amended and supplemented accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Wayne in the County of Passaic, State of New Jersey as follows [additions by bold, deletions by strikethrough]:

SECTION 1. Chapter 200 (Vehicles and Traffic), Article XI (Schedules), Section 200-45 (Schedule XVII: Prohibited Turns at Intersections) of the Code of the Township of Wayne is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

Name of Street	Direction of Travel	Prohibited Turn	At Intersection of
Armstrong Avenue	East	Left	Paterson-Hamburg Turnpike
Paterson-Hamburg Turnpike	North	Left	Armstrong Avenue
Paterson-Hamburg Turnpike	South	Right	Armstrong Avenue

SECTION 2. All other provisions of Chapter 200 of the Code of the Township of Wayne shall remain unchanged.

SECTION 3. Upon introduction and prior to adoption of this ordinance, the Township Clerk shall forward a copy of this ordinance to the County of Passaic pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8a.

SECTION 4: Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, sub-section, sentence, clause, phrase, or any other part of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance, but shall remain in effect; it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

SECTION 5: Repeal of Inconsistent Provisions. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

SECTION 6: Codification. This Ordinance shall be a part of the Code of the Township of Wayne as though codified and fully set forth therein. The Township Clerk shall have this ordinance codified and incorporated in the official copies of the Code. The Township Clerk and the Township Attorney are authorized and directed to change any Chapter, Article and/or Section number of the Code of the Township of Wayne in the event that the codification of this Ordinance reveals that there is a conflict between the numbers and the existing Code, and in order to avoid confusion and possible accidental repealers of existing provisions not intended to be repealed.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage by Council and approval by the Mayor in the manner prescribed by law at N.J.S.A. 40:69A-181 and with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Passaic pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.2.
