ORDINANCE NO. 2023-11

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WATERFORD AMENDING CHAPTER 235 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE CAPTIONED "SOLID WASTE"

WHEREAS, it has been determined necessary to amend Chapter 235 of the Township Code captioned "Solid Waste", Article V captioned "Yard Waste and Bulk Waste", Section 235-18 captioned "Yard Waste" to revise Section A captioned "Collection Standards" as follows.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Waterford, County of Camden, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of this Section A the following terms, phrases, words and their derivations shall have the meaning stated herein unless their use in the text of this Chapter clearly demonstrates a different meaning. When not inconsistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future, words used in the plural number includes the singular number, and words used in the singular number include the plural number. The word "shall" is always mandatory and not merely directory.

- (1) Containerize means the placement of yard waste in a trashcan, bucket, bag or other vessel, such as to prevent the yard waste from spilling or blowing out into the street and coming into contact with stormwater.
- (2) Person Any individual, corporation, company, partnership firm, association, or political subdivision of this State subject to municipal jurisdiction.
- (3) Street means any street, avenue, boulevard, road, parkway, viaduct, drive, or other way, which is an existing State, County or Municipal roadway, and includes the land between the street lines, whether improved or unimproved, and may comprise pavement, shoulders, gutters, curbs, sidewalks, parking areas, and other areas within the street lines.

(4) Yard Waste – means leaves and grass clippings and also includes the definition in Section

35-1.

(5) Designated yard waste shall be placed entirely within a yard waste container and shall not

be placed in the street. If yard waste is placed within the street and is not placed within

the yard waste container, the responsible party must remove the yard waste from the street

or said party will be deemed in violation of this Article.

(6) Yard waste must be placed within a container and not exceed fifty (50) pounds and not

exceed the height of the yard waste container.

(7) No bags shall be placed within the yard waste container.

(8) Yard waste which is designated for placement inside the yard waste container but is placed

along the curb and outside of the container in a bag or any receptacle other than the yard

waste container will not be collected by the Township.

Section 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances that are inconsistent with this Ordinance

are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

Section 3. If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause

of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such order of

judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph,

subdivision or clause of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall only take effect after final adoption and publication as

required by law.
