#### INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW NO. 6 OF 2024

# A LOCAL LAW OF THE TOWN OF WALLKILL, COUNTY OF ORANGE, AMENDING CHAPTER SECTION 182 OF THE TOWN CODE RELATING TO FOOD TRUCKS

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF WALLKILL AS FOLLOWS:

#### Section 1. Purpose

Currently Wallkill Town Code Section 182-17(E) provides that a maximum of four operating permits will be issued to any food truck operator in any given year. The Town Board wishes to modify the foregoing restriction in order to allow food truck operators to obtain a permit for Town sponsored events and not have such events count against the established annual limitation. It is therefore necessary to amend the Town Code to reflect this change and clarify the Town's procedures.

#### Section 2.

The Town of Wallkill Code, Chapter 182, Article II, Section 182-17 entitled "Permit; fees" is hereby amended by adding the following highlighted language to the end of subsection "E":

E. Permits shall be issued on a special event duration basis. Applications for such permits shall be available to residents or established businesses located within the Town of Wallkill. The number of permits issued each year to any individual or business applicant will be determined by the Town Board. A maximum of four permits will be issued to any food truck operator each calendar year. Notwithstanding the foregoing, food truck permits issued in connection with Town-sponsored events shall not be counted towards the maximum number of four permits in such calendar year.

#### Section 3. Separability

If any provision of this local law or the application thereof to any person or circumstance be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part or provision or application directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this local law or the application thereof to other persons or circumstances, and the Town Board of the Town of Wallkill hereby declares that it would have passed this local law or the remainder thereof had such invalid application or invalid provision been apparent.

# Section 4. Statutory Authority

This local law is enacted in accordance with the powers granted to the Town Board pursuant to the provisions of Article 16 of the New York State Town Law and Article 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, pursuant to which the Town Board has the authority to enact local laws and amend local laws for the purpose of promoting the health, safety or general welfare of the Town of Wallkill and for the protection and enhancement of its physical environment.

# Section 5. Repeal

All ordinances, local laws and parts thereof inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby repealed.

# Section 6. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
